The IBE is integrated by leading experts that cover a wide range of evolutionary biology subjects, from phylogenomic research and molecular physiology and functional genomics based on model and non-model organisms, to comparative and computational genomics.

The Institute of Evolutionary Biology (CSIC-UPF) is a joint research Institute belonging to the Spanish National Research Council (CSIC) and the Pompeu Fabra University (UPF).

CSIC is the main public research body in Spain and the third largest in Europe.

UPF is considered the best Spanish University concerning student attraction and teaching quality, and it is positioned among the best Spanish Universities with respect to quality of research and doctorate studies.

Furthermore, IBE is integrated in the Barcelona Parc de Recerca Biomèdica de Barcelona-PRBB, one of the largest biomedical research clusters in Southern Europe.

PhD MENTORING PROGRAM

The mentoring program is an opportunity for the students to interact and rely on scientists that are not directly involved in their PhD work, to obtain an objective analysis of their performance and personal growth. During their PhD, the students meet once a year with the committee. Before the meeting. the student and Pls independently answer a confidential questionnaire designed to detect possible misalignments in their professional expectations, progress, or relationship. The committee analyses the answers and, after meeting with both Pl and students separately, suggests recommendations to improve the quality of their performance and professional relationship.
